




Closed Forest Tree Species Composition. Legend

apparent areas in Siberia and the Russian Far East




Plant communities in large apparent blocks of intact closed forest by Ff_type

-  European northern taiga spruce forests (*Picea abies*; *Picea obovata*) partly in combination with birch forests and sphagnum swamps
-  European middle taiga spruce forests (*Picea abies*; *Picea obovata*) partly in combination with birch and aspen forests, sphagnum swamps and swamp meadow
-  Siberian northern taiga forests (*Picea obovata*; *Pinus sibirica*; *Larix sibirica*) partly in combination with sphagnum swamps
-  Siberian middle taiga forests (*Picea obovata*; *Pinus sibirica*; *Abies sibirica*) partly in combination with sphagnum swamps and birch forests
-  Siberian southern taiga forests (*Picea obovata*; *Pinus sibirica*; *Abies sibirica*) partly in combination with sphagnum swamps, aspen and birch forests
-  Siberian dark coniferous mountain forests
-  Dark coniferous mountain forests in combination with mixed coniferous-broadleaved forests (Far Eastern group)
-  European-West Siberian northern taiga pine forests, partly in combination with sphagnum swamps
-  European-West Siberian middle and southern taiga pine forests, partly in combination with sphagnum swamps
-  Siberian grassy-undershrub pine and larch-pine forests in combination with lichen-undershrub pine forests
-  West Siberian northern taiga mossy undershrub and lichen-undershrub larch forests (*Larix sibirica*, *Pinus sibirica*, *Picea obovata*) in combination with spruce-larch and pine-larch forests
-  Middle Siberian middle taiga undershrub and grassy-undershrub larch forests (*Larix daurica*, *Larix sibirica*)
-  Far Eastern wild rosemary larch forests in combinations with grassy and peat moss larch swamp forests (*mari*)
-  Far Eastern grassy and peat moss larch swamp forests (*mari*) partly in combination with wild rosemary larch forests and swamps
-  Northern taiga mountain open larch woodlands
-  East Siberian middle taiga mountain larch forests
-  Southern Siberian mountain larch forests (*Larix sibirica*)
-  Southern Siberian mountain larch-stone pine forests (*Larix sibirica*, *Pinus sibirica*) in combination with stone pine mountain forests
-  Far Eastern deciduous forests (*Quercus mongolica*, *Tilia amurensis* etc.)
-  Not classified areas inside Intact Forest Landscapes
